Committee: Student Debt Principal Authors: David McLaughlin (Pat Roberts), Thane McGrath (Tim Scott) Bill No: **Submission Date: 11/11/16 Title of Bill:** Financial Transparency BE IT ENACTED BY THE ANIMAS HIGH SCHOOL MODEL CONGRESS 1 Preamble: Whereas, in 1940s, college debt was not a problem, and since it has become a 2 more apparent issue, and since colleges don't inform students about the amount of debt they 3 will be in, and since students aren't made aware of their debt they don't know how much 4 they should be saving/paying a month to pay off their student debt after graduation, and 5 since there is a student loan delinquency rate of 11.1%, and since the total student debt in **6** America is \$1.26 Trillion, 8 SECTION 1: Enforce colleges to give the total interest rate information during the signup process for the college, to make sure that students know what they are paying. 10 11 SECTION 2: Enforce colleges to make an estimate on the total amount and give an automatic update on the total every month or whenever the student or parents 12 13 need to see such total amount. 14 15 SECTION 3: Enforce colleges to make sure that families are made aware how much the student will be in debt after loans, scholarships and financial aid, make it so that families may choose to steer their child into school based on economic value 17 18 19 SECTION 4: Ensure that each student gets an estimate based on students college life, by---20 Sub-SECTION A: Each student must be aware of how much the cost of all their 21 classes after 2 - 4 years will be, Sub-SECTION B: Each student must be aware of how much the cost of all their 22 23 housing and food costs after 2 - 4 years will be. 24 <u>Sub-SECTION C</u>: Each student must be aware of the total cost of their tuition 25 after scholarships and if they had any classes they failed and retake, 26 (A) If a student failed a class they will still have to pay the 27 amount charged for that class 28 (B) If a student retakes a class they will also still be paying 29 the regular amount 30 31 SECTION 5: Require colleges to make aware to its students in plain english that there is **32** available financial transparency

Sub-SECTION A: Always have the subject of financial transparency be in its

own section and not put into emails or letters with other information

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<u>Sub-SECTION B:</u> Make it so that students and their families are aware of the debt the student will be enduring, in hopes that students will look for colleges based on financial status

SECTION 6: This bill shall go into effect 94 days after passage.
